I am contacting you to let you know about a cheque presentation that is taking place at Britz on the Wilton Road, on Tuesday 7th April.

With the help and support of our customers we have raise £3502.86 for the Royal National Mission to Deep Sea Fishermen (RNMDSF). This has been done via donations in our large charity box (it is child friendly and when the money is placed in it rotates round and round until falling in the box), and other fund raising events.

The RNMDSF is a charity who support the families, widows and children, of the fishermen who are lost and injured at sea. The real cost of fishing is their lives. Fishing ranks as the most dangerous occupation.

The presentatoin will be taking place at 2:00p.m. at Britz with Tim Mowat from the Mission, Helen Houghton (Company Standards Manager), myself and staff from Coach Caterers who run Britz.

Britz is family run and has been in existence for over 5 years. They have been holders of the Friers Quality awards each year, a great achievement for all members of the team.

Due to our fundraising efforts over the years, (one year we raised £6263.62 - when I cycled from Lands End to John O'Groats in 10 days), we are being awarded 'Best Fundraising Company 2008' at the 123rd AGM & awards in London on the 22nd April.
